#### ADMINISTRATOR'S CORNER

Hello!

Thank you to everyone that has been presenting their membership cards to the bartenders; they appreciate it. As I mentioned in a previous newsletter, you can register your ID on the International website: [www.mooseintl.org](http://www.mooseintl.org). Then you will always have an electronic copy of your membership record in case you lose or forget your card. This also allows you to edit your own information – i.e., address, phone number, email address, etc. This is where you can identify yourself as a veteran too. We have many snowbirds; you have the ability to enter an alternate address. When you come and go between your warm happy place and home, just log in and check the box of your current address. That way you never miss another exciting issue of the newsletter.

As some of you have noticed, I have been emailing the newsletter to all email addresses that I have available to me. I get the list every cycle from the International database of active members. If you have not received an email, then you have none on record, or have changed it since your application. If you would like to receive an email in the future, go to your membership record on the International website above and enter your current address. I am also putting together an opt-out list for those that do not want to receive a hard copy. Simply reply to the newsletter email with your name and "Opt-out". If we can save a few bucks on printing and postage, that means more funds available for our mission of supporting Mooseheart, Moosehaven, and our own community. Keep in mind, this only applies to the men. I currently do not have access to the Women's records, and they have their own means of emailing. Also keep in mind that the newsletter gets posted on our website; [lodge437.moosepages.org](http://lodge437.moosepages.org); so it can be accessed there too.

Just a few housecleaning items before I go: The tobacco ban that was approved at the last International Convention went into effect January 1. No tobacco products of any kind are allowed in any lodges. We have received permission to continue using our smoke room, so all smoking or chewing are restricted to that room or outside. 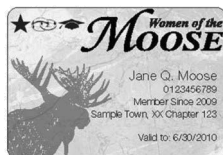

### MOOSE GUEST POLICY

Only the following persons may be admitted as a "qualified guest" into the social quarters or home of any lodge of the Order:

A: An active lodge or chapter member's spouse. (Note – There are no limits on the number of times a spouse may be admitted as a guest.)

B: An active lodge or chapter member's immediate family. (Note – There are no limits on the number of times a spouse or qualified family member under the age of 21 may be admitted as a guest, however, all other immediate family members would be limited to two visits as they now qualify as a prospective member of the person signing them into the social quarters.)

C: A prospective member is defined as any guest that is accompanied by a member who can sponsor them for membership in the Order, with the exception listed in (A) of this section. As permitted by the House Committee, a prospective member may be admitted subject to the following:

- (1) The prospective member is accompanied at all times by his or her sponsor.
- (2) The prospective member is properly signed in as a guest.
- (3) The prospective member shall not make purchases.
- (4) The prospective member shall leave when his or her sponsor leaves.
- (5) The prospective member shall be limited to two (2) visits.

All adult guests of members must be signed in as a guest and leave when the member leaves.
